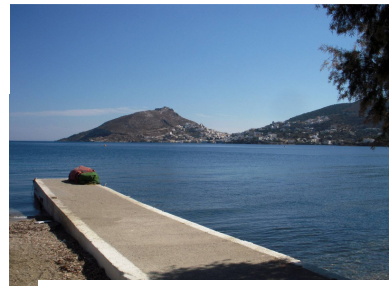
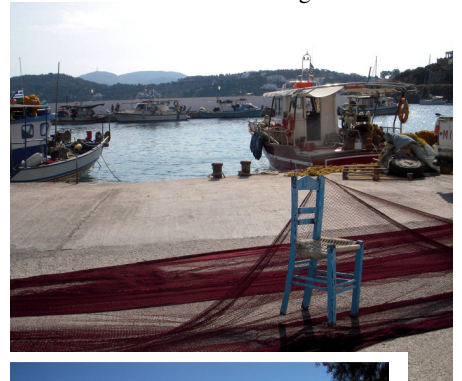
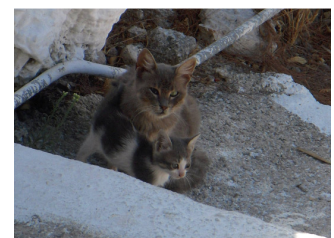
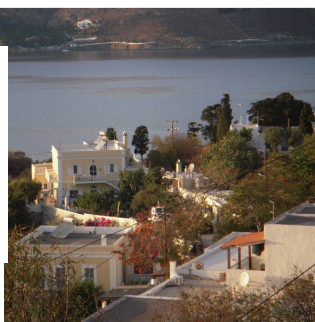
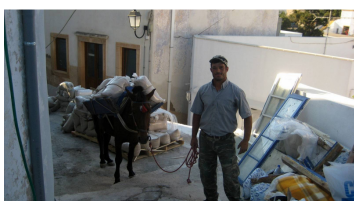


Leaving Leros-Autumn Images.
